



# DIY A/C TROUBLESHOOTING

Save money on HVAC service calls with these troubleshooting tips.

**1. Set your unit to cool.**

Sometimes an accidental bump could switch your unit into the off position.

**2. A dirty air filter can block the airflow to your unit, leading to a shutdown.** Consult your manual, and change your filter in the recommended intervals.

**3. Clean and unblock your registers** to protect your unit and to ensure that your unit is receiving proper airflow.

**4. Sometimes an unexpected A/C shutdown can be the result of a simple breaker trip.** Check your fuse box!

**5. Holes or gaps in your ductwork can leak air.** Examine your attic and crawlspace if you are having problems.

**6. In the small grey box outside, check to see if the disconnect switch is in the on position.** If it is in the off position, reset it, but be mindful of potential voltage hazards!

**7. A build-up of leaves or grass clippings around your outdoor unit could interrupt your service.** Keep it clean!
